Required Documents for Visa Appointment Services

• Passport:

Original passport with at least six months of validity beyond the intended stay. Minimum of two blank visa pages.

Photocopies of relevant passport pages (information page and any previous visas).

• Visa Application Form:

Completed and printed visa application form specific to the country of travel (DS-160 for the USA, online IRCC form for Canada, specific forms for European countries).

Visa Fee Payment Receipt:

Proof of visa fee payment (receipt) specific to the application (non-refundable fee for the USA, IRCC fee for Canada, country-specific fees for Europe).

• Biometrics Instruction Letter (BIL) (if applicable):

Required for countries that mandate biometrics (fingerprints and photo). Bring the BIL to the biometrics appointment.

Appointment Confirmation:

Printout of the appointment confirmation from the embassy, consulate, or VFS Global.

Photograph:

Recent passport-sized photo that meets the specific country's visa requirements (U.S. visa guidelines, Canadian specifications, or specific European country requirements).

• Financial Proof:

Bank statements or other evidence demonstrating financial capability to support the stay. Any additional financial documents as required by the specific visa type.

Travel Plans:

Travel itinerary, including flight bookings and accommodation details. Proof of accommodation (hotel reservations or invitation letter from a host).

Supporting Documents:

Documents supporting the purpose of the visit, such as: Invitation letters (if visiting family, friends, or for business purposes). Employment verification letter.

Business registration documents (if applicable).

Academic documents (if traveling for education).

Sponsorship letters (if applicable).

• Travel Insurance (for European Schengen Visas):

Proof of travel insurance that covers medical emergencies for the duration of the stay.

Additional Documents (if applicable):

Proof of enrollment or admission (if traveling for education).

Marriage certificate or relationship proof (if applicable).

Any specific documents requested by the consulate or embassy based on the visa type.

• Tracking Number (for Canada and European Consulate Appointments):

Provided by VFS Global after submission of the visa application to monitor the application status.
